



2023 Updated UFMG Special Projects Grant Application Criteria

Grant Criteria: Awards are between \$2,000 and \$10,000

- Project must relate directly to wellness or patient care.
- Benefit more than half of your target population.
- Serve those in Gainesville/Alachua County.
- Must be a nonprofit organization to apply.

These items may NOT be included in the grant:

- Items covered by operating budgets, salaries.
- Printing, copying, or mailing costs.
- Food served at events, facility charges, insurance, or travel.
- Research studies not approved by Institutional Review Board (IRB). You must submit proof of IRB approval if applying for research study funding.

If a report describing how funds were spent is not submitted by the end of the grant cycle, applications from that entity will not be considered in subsequent years.

New in 2023: UF Health Pediatrics and UF Health Rehab Services please take note:

This year, applications will be received by UF Medical Guild at ufmgspecialprojects@gmail.com and forwarded to UF Health Pediatrics and UF Health Rehab Services. Administration from these areas will review the applications and decide how to allocate funds. UF Medical Guild will award a lump sum to these departments. Administration will submit a report on how the funds were spent.

- Applications will be accepted from **May 1 until midnight on May 31, 2023.**
